2017 Weed Abatement Season

By the authority of Health & Safety Code 14892, notice is hereby given that on March 23, 2017, the Board of Directors of the North Central Fire Protection District passed a resolution declaring that any weeds, grasses, and/or combustible rubbish constitute a public nuisance within the District and **MUST BE REMOVED**.

The deadline for removing such weeds, grasses and/or combustible rubbish is May 1, 2017. If your property does not contain weeds, grasses and/or combustible rubbish or they have already been removed, no action is required. If they are not removed by the deadline, the North Central Fire Protection District shall remove them from the property. All costs of such removal shall be assessed upon the property and the costs will constitute a lien upon the property until paid. If the weeds, grasses and/or combustible rubbish are not removed and a fire should occur on your property, you may be subject to all costs related to fire suppression.

All property owners having any objections to the proposed enforcement will be notified to attend a public hearing so their objection can be heard and given due consideration.
