A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTH CENTRAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 ADOPTED BUDGET

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (the "Board") OF THE NORTH CENTRAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (the "District") RESOLVES, FINDS, AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

During the 2022-23 Fiscal Year the District will receive \$496,900 in unanticipated revenues from state and local funding sources. These revenues will be appropriated to personnel and operating expenditure line items in the adopted budget as follows:

In addition, as the majority of expenditures were incurred in Fiscal Year 2022-23 related to the Fire Station #59 improvement project, approval of the First Amendment would increase the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Capital Budget by \$420,000 above the estimated appropriations included in the budget. In addition, \$686,634 is being appropriated in the Capital Budget related to the purchase of two fire apparatus from the City of Fowler approved by the Board in March 2023.
